

ORAL BISPHOSPHONATE ADMINISTRATION*

Once a week: alendronate 70 mg risedronate 35 mg

Once a month: risedronate 150 mg



First thing in the morning, on an empty stomach

DO NOT give with any other morning medications.

It will NOT be absorbed or effective if given after eating.





With a full glass of water

DO NOT administer with milk, juice, coffee, tea, etc.

It will NOT be absorbed or effective if given with anything other than water.



Resident/patient should wait 30 min (60 min preferred) before eating or drinking, including other medications.

The medication needs time to be absorbed.

Absorption will stop when food or other medications enter the stomach.



Do NOT crush/allow chewing of medication.

It will NOT be well absorbed and may damage the esophagus or cause sores in the mouth if not taken whole.



Patient should NOT lie down post-dose. Patient can sit or stand or walk.

Patient can lie down AFTER breakfast- 30 min post dose (60min preferred).

DANGER: Lying down after this medication may lead to an esophageal ulcer which may bleed or perforate.



^{*}Actonel DR (Actonel DR™) <u>MUST</u> be given WITH breakfast.
